- **No race day registration.** All registrations must be received by 11:59 pm on Thursday, June 26th.
- All paddlers must complete the [Release Of Liability Waiver](#) in order to enter the race.
- Teams must be registered by one contact person per form.
 - ◆ Contact person ensures waivers are completed for their team, and turns in payment for each racer at the registration desk the morning of the race. Canoe number and colors must be provided at that time, if not already entered on the form.
- Payment accepted by cash, check made out to Mountain Home Canoe Club, or Zelle (treasurer@manuahale.org) to be submitted on race day.

Registration fee: (includes 1 raffle ticket, race swag and insurance coverage)

OC-6 - \$45 per paddler (\$270 per canoe)

Junior & Youth OC-6 - \$20 per paddler (\$120 per canoe)

Small boat/SUP - \$45 per paddler, included if racing in OC-6

The Race

Full course approx. 10.5 miles heading upriver for 4 miles, looping counter-clockwise around Phoca Island, head downriver for the last turn counter clockwise to head back towards the finish line. Short course approx. 5 miles. Actual race courses may change on race day pending wind and water conditions.

Insurance is provided by Paddlesport Risk Management, LLC. The race will follow PNWORCA race rules, regulations and safety procedures ([PNWORCA Race Rules - PNWORCA](#)).

Six functional PFDs, at least one working bailer and a whistle per boat. Safety boats will be on the course to assist, but are not responsible for paddlers, boats or equipment. Please make sure your crews are comfortable with huli procedures. All small boat and SUP paddlers must wear a PFD and have a leash.

Parking: Daily park entrance fee \$5 per vehicle at the gate.

- First-come, first-serve camping is available at the race site (sites B, D, & E) Friday and/or Saturday evening included in the daily parking fee.

Food: The Mexican Food Truck is back! We will be selling food tickets at the registration tent that can be redeemed for food at the truck.

- Water, Coffee, and Snacks will be provided.
